**Description of the event/activity
(min 250 words)**

On September 15, 2025, an **Intensified Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) Campaign** was organized at the Gulabrao Patil Memorial Trust's Institute of Nursing Sciences. The primary objective of this initiative was to heighten awareness regarding HIV/AIDS and to refine the clinical identification of new cases within the community through nursing excellence. The campaign was spearheaded by three expert lecturers who addressed the students and staff:

- **Mrs. Sanjivani Vibhute** opened the session by outlining the epidemiology of HIV/AIDS. She emphasized the "95-95-95" global targets, stressing that the first step—identifying 95% of those living with HIV—is critical for epidemic control.
- **Mrs. Nanda Kamble** focused on the psychosocial dimensions. She trained participants on reducing stigma and discrimination, which often act as barriers to voluntary testing. Her session highlighted the importance of empathetic counseling in encouraging at-risk individuals to seek diagnosis.
- **Mr. Vishnu Mane** provided a technical demonstration on active case finding. He discussed modern screening protocols, the use of Integrated Counseling and Testing Centers (ICTC), and the legal frameworks protecting patient confidentiality.

Impact and Conclusion

The program successfully equipped future nursing professionals with the communication skills and diagnostic knowledge required for effective field intervention. By the end of the session, students demonstrated a clear understanding of the referral chain for Antiretroviral Therapy (ART). The campaign concluded with a commitment to conduct community outreach programs in local Miraj neighborhoods to identify and support undiagnosed cases.

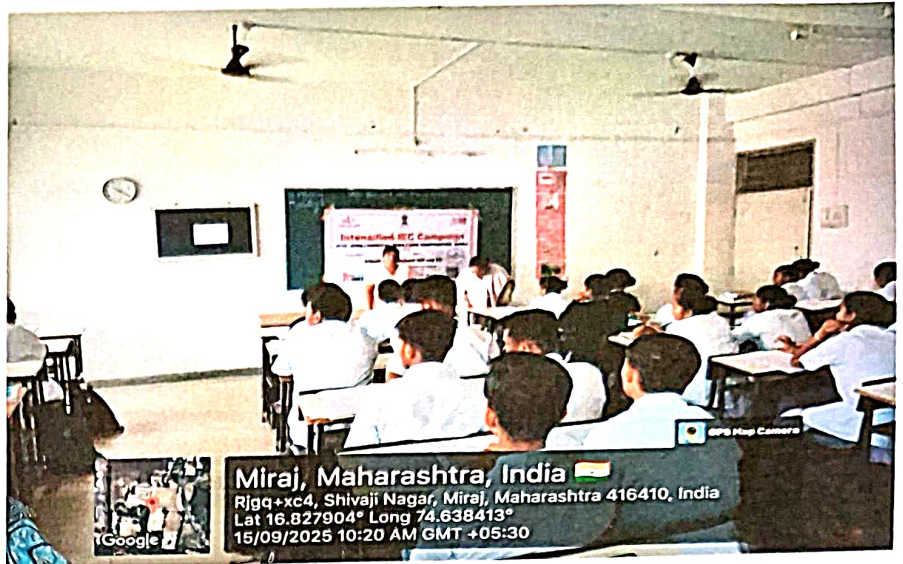


